"Jaggo" literally translates to "wake up!" This energetic pre-wedding party is a night filled with loud music, open dancing, and colorful traditions. It is a festive, high-energy event where guests are encouraged to let loose. Here is your guide to dressing for this unforgettable night.



The Jaggo Vibe & Color Palette

The Rule of Thumb: The brighter, the better! This is not the time for muted tones.

Encouraged: Hot pinks, vivid oranges, bright yellows, emerald greens, and shimmering golds. Heavy embroidery, sequins, and bold patterns are perfect for this lively night.



Women's Attire

Since the Jaggo involves traditional Punjabi dancing (Giddha and Bhangra), comfort and mobility are essential.



Patiala Suit: A classic choice. These feature a short tunic paired with highly pleated, draped trousers that are incredibly comfortable and traditional.



Lehenga Choli: A flared skirt and blouse. Perfect for twirling on the dance floor!



Sharara or Gharara: Flowy, wide-legged pants paired with a tunic.



The Phulkari Dupatta: A vibrantly embroidered traditional Punjabi scarf. Even if you wear a simple outfit, throwing a Phulkari over your shoulders will instantly give you the perfect Jaggo look!



Men's Attire

Men should aim for festive, colorful semi-formal wear that allows for movement.



Kurta Pajama: A colorful tunic over lightweight trousers. This is the ultimate, comfortable Jaggo uniform for men.



Nehru Jacket / Waistcoat: Elevate a simple Kurta or a Western button-down shirt by adding a brightly colored, patterned, or embroidered vest.



Western Smart Casual: Chinos or dress pants paired with a crisp dress shirt. Ties are optional and usually taken off once the dancing starts!



ESSENTIAL JAGGO TIPS

Footwear is Crucial: You *will* be dancing! Leave the stilettos at home. Opt for traditional flats (Punjabi Juttis), block heels, or comfortable wedges.

No Head Coverings Needed: Unlike the Gurdwara ceremony, you do not need to cover your head during the Jaggo party.

Bring the Energy: The most important accessory is a big smile and readiness to dance the night away!
